The role:

To support and teach our students Photography as part of the Co-curricular programme.

Main duties and Responsibilities:

• To plan and organise photography sessions during Period 7 as allocated

- Help maintain and recommend equipment and supplies needed for Period 7 Photography
- Deliver effective feedback to students on their Photography
- Maintain, foster and develop the school's Co-curricular Foundation Skills.
- Be responsible for the welfare, health and safety of students in their care, reporting any concerns or breaches of guidelines or behaviour to the appropriate person.
- Attend school INSET/ CPD days and staff meetings and events as required

The Photography Coach will have:

- Experience of coaching/teaching Photography within schools/clubs.
- Excellent knowledge of Photography styles & practices for young people.
- Good technical and professional knowledge of Photography with a passion to develop further in order to raise and maintain standards within the department.
- Excellent communication skills, with the ability to motivate others.
